Energy Centre

- **Target of subsidy:** increase of RES use, increase of energy efficiency (EE), decrease of CO₂ emissions, development of rural regions
- **Total financial source** of assistance in 2004: 1.2 billion HUF (4,8 Million €)
- **Minimum total investment cost** for an investment: 125 million HUF (500 thousand €)
- **Maximum subsidy** given for an investment: 300 million HUF (1,2 Million €)
- **Duration of application period:**
 - 16 February 2004 – 24 May 2004
 - 15 September 2004 – 31 December 2006

Organisations entitled for subsidies

- **Target Group 1.**
 - Central budgetary organisations and its institutions
 - Local municipality organisations and its institutions
 - Non-profit organisations
 - Companies with the majority ownership of municipalities
 - Foundations, unions
 - Churches, public entities
 - Associations and their non-profit consortiums
- **Target Group 2.**
 - Small and medium sized enterprises (SME)

Project Generation Facility -PGF

- *Aim:* preparation of high standard projects where investments can begin in the 2004-2006 period in case of receipt of ERDF or ESF subsidies.
- PGF offers administrative and professional background, organisations...etc for carrying out projects rather than direct financial assistance.
