**Importance of LEAs**

- Instrument for Achieving EU Policy Goals
  - (e.g. "An Energy Policy for Europe - the need for action" launched in 2007):
  - reducing greenhouse gas emissions from developed countries by 30%;
  - improving energy efficiency by 20%;
  - raising the share of renewable energy to 20%; and
  - increasing the level of biofuels in transport fuel to 10%
- Information conduit on EU policy
- Solve real and pressing Energy Efficiency problems in their locality
- Source of Good Practice on EE for Local Actors
- Access to a Europe-wide network



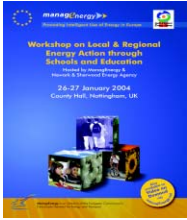

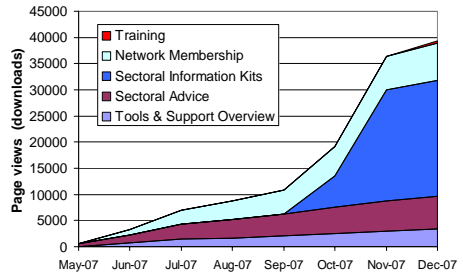
## Management Resources and Tools for LEAs
