Tim has been involved in the development and management of major initiatives in Wales, Cornwall and in other parts of the UK.

During this time he has initiated various partnerships involving local authorities, arts, heritage and community organisations. Since 2000 he has been responsible for the Cornwall Local Authority Support Programme and the development and management of the Cornwall Sustainable Energy Partnership (CSEP).

CSEP is based at Community Energy Plus at Tolvaddon Energy Park, Camborne. The Local Authority Support Programme (funded by the Energy Saving Trust) aims to develop supportive mechanisms for energy efficiency and sustainable energy work involving local authorities. In Cornwall the work has resulted in the Cornwall Sustainable Energy Partnership, which involves over 60 organisations including all local authorities, the health sector including all primary care trusts, housing associations, businesses, voluntary and community organisations, educational establishments, and the environment and renewable energy sectors.

One of the main initiatives of the partnership is Home Health, an Energy Efficiency home improvement scheme currently operating in West Cornwall involving GPs and community groups in the process, and due to cover the whole of the county by 2010. The partnership continues to prove itself as an extremely successful mechanism for developing and progressing programmes, accessing funding and informing national energy debates, strategies and policies. The launch of the Cornwall Energy Strategy consolidates the role of the Partnership and its role in the delivery of actions to achieve a sustainable energy future for the residents and businesses of Cornwall.

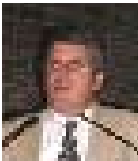
