**Commission launches major investment programme for innovative low-carbon technologies**

The European Commission launched in November 2010 a major investment programme for innovative low-carbon technologies. The initiative, known as the 'Innovation and Demonstration Programme', will provide substantial financial support for all types of projects involving innovative renewable energy technologies and energy efficiency technologies. The programme will be implemented over the next five years, with a total budget of 1.5 billion euros.
